- The aim of our junior section is to ensure there is a fun and inclusive environment for young people to enjoy the sport we love.
- Development of young people and cricketers is important to us, fun, safety and inclusivity is at the heart of everything we aim to do.
- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Parent communication with team managers is essential to ensure your child has a positive experience with us.
- Members should wear appropriate sportswear for training and where possible club kit for matches, any problems should be discussed with the coach/team manager.
- Please pay your membership fee in a timely manner, we are happy to discuss any financial concerns you may have to ensure there is no barrier to participation.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Any degree of aggressive behavior or violence will result in disciplinary action taking place.
- Offensive language will not be tolerated and will result in disciplinary action.

Members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with club safeguarding officers.
