



## Code of Conduct for Members and Guests

All Members and Guests of *Astley & Tyldesley CC* will:

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person in all contexts
- Treat everyone equally and not discriminate on the grounds of age, gender, disability, race, ethnic origin, nationality, colour, parental or marital status, religious belief, class or social background, sexual preference or political belief
- Not condone, or allow to go unchallenged, any form of discrimination if witnessed
- Display high standards of behavior
- Promote the positive aspects of Cricket e.g. fair play
- Encourage all participants to learn the Laws and rules and play within them, respecting the decisions of match officials
- Actively discourage unfair play, rule violations and arguing with match officials
- Recognise good performance not just match results
- Place the well-being and safety of young people at the heart of everything
- Ensure that activities are appropriate for the age, maturity, experience and ability of the individual
- Respect Young People's opinions when making decisions about their participation
- Not smoke, drink or use banned substances whilst actively working with young people
- Not provide Young People with alcohol
- Follow ECB guidelines set out in ECB Safeguards policy
- Any degree of aggressive behavior or violence will result in disciplinary action taking place.
- Offensive language will not be tolerated and will result in disciplinary action.
- Refer to other policies of the club (e.g. Bullying Policy), understand and action them.
